

Also, during summer break I got to go to a couple different places (Constanza and Jarabacoa) with my family and friends.


I hope that during my school breaks this year they will take me to see other places.



"Called to Care" for Our Community SCC Emergency Funds (budget \$3,000)

"Love your neighbor as yourself." — Mark 12:31

By ministering within our own neighborhoods, SCC believers directly impact our local community. Meeting tangible needs, sharing the Gospel, and building relationships contribute to transformation at the grassroots level.

Most importantly local mission encourages each of us as Christians to "look after our neighbors." Our neighbor—whether sitting next to us in church, living on our streets or living in our community—can experience Christ as we extend love, comfort, and care to those in need. Some of the ways that SCC helps our neighbors in an emergency are: gas cards when they need to get to medical appointments or work; portions of back rent when they about to be evicted; light car repair and assistance with utilities; help with emergency bills or need for medications, food, and clothing through the Christian Service Center. Our help to those in need is aimed to be a one-time gift and we do place a maximum dollar on the amount given in most instances. We encourage the people to set up budgets and seek help with their finances. We also extend an invitation to worship with us and offer prayers and Bibles, if wanted.

God also knows these experiences have the power to change us (SCC) at our core as we take our eyes off ourselves and look beyond our own needs. There is nothing to earn or gain through our actions. Serving our neighbor is simply giving thanks for what Jesus has done. To

quote Martin Luther, "God does not need your good works, but your neighbor does."

DR Mission Trip etc.. Due date for our next *RaiseRight* scrip gift card order is **Sunday, March 10th,** which will be available March 14th at the church office. Delivery of cards can also be arranged. Contact Mark with your order or order online by visiting www.raiseright.com. Contact the Scrip coordinator if you need Saranac Community Church's enrollment code. It is very easy to do this and your order is automatically sent to our church scrip coordinator. You may also bring your payment to church or pay online for a small 29¢ fee. Remember, you can reload or print many cards at **any time** during the month if you enroll in *PrestoPay*. Use the *RaiseRight* scrip phone app to make ordering easier. Scrip also now offers the option of having select gift cards shipped directly to you any time during the month for an additional fee. There are usually a limited number of Meijer and Speedway scrip cards available for purchase in the church office as well. If you have any questions on how this program works please contact Scrip Coordinator Mark Fritsma (MarkF@wowway.com). Earn rebates to reduce the cost of sending SCC kids to Portage Lake, Branch Adventures or a similar camp. UNITE (CHIC) returns in 2024 as well. You can still participate and help build the scholarship fund even if you do not have a camp aged child. We also consider scholarship requests for church related functions, such as retreats and mission trips, from adults as well. Due date for next month's order is April 14th.
